#### Congregational.

Mrs. Kiek, who has just obtained the degree of B.D. at the Melbourne College of Divinity, was educated at Urmoston Higher Grade School, near Manchester. She later matriculated at the Victoria University, Manchester, and took the B.A. degree there, obtaining in the second year a first-class pass in every subject. She was head of the list in education, physiography, and was given the University prize in logic. On her marriage with the Rev. E. S. Kiek, M.A., B.D., she removed to Staffordshire, where acquaintance was made with life in the potteries. Always keen on practical subjects, Mrs. Kiek confined her studies to esperanto, and three branches of nursing, while taking up responsibilities in connection with various organizations. She served the North Staffordshire branch of the London Missionary Society, the Girl Guides Committee, the Women's National Council, the fund for Belgian refugees, the brotherhood and sisterhood movements. On coming to Adelaide Mrs. Kiek decided to work for the B.D. degree in her spare time. She had been keenly interested in theology from childhood, and moreover was desirous of utilizing any success she might gain for the benefit of the students at Parkin College. The subjects for the final B.D. degree include Old and New Testament with set portions of Hebrew and Greek, Biblical and historical theology, patriotics (Greek and Latin fathers), and comparative religions. Mrs. Kiek attended lectures at Parkin College given by the Rev. A. H. Bell, B.A., B.D., of Prospect, Rev. L. Robjohns, B.A., of Kensington Gardens, and Principal Kiek, and has also taken one subject by private study. Mrs. Kiek is so heartily congratulated on the fact that she is the first woman in Australia to take the B.D. degree.

From Messrs. Methuen & Co. comes Professor Einstein's latest book on relativity "The Meaning of Relativity" by Albert Einstein; translated by Edwin Plimpton Adams. It consists of four lectures given by him at Princeton University, but they are for reading, and much slower reading than the other two books of Einstein which have been translated. This one is merciless in its mathematics. There is not one diagram, the numbered equations amount to 124, and the quantities in them are usually tensors—a word not yet in the dictionary, and a notion nearly new even to students of mathematical physics. The descriptive language, though as clear as ever, is hardly less inhuman; it is mainly about invariants, co-variants, skew-symmetry, and the like. Yes, it is all crabbled enough, but that is as it should be. There are not the mathematics and also the theory of relativity; the theory is the mathematics. If, as Poincare said, a law of nature is a differential equation, then the system of equations expounded in this book is the very system of nature itself as a system. The three empirical tests are dealt with again, in order to show why they are inevitable if the theory is true; but they are merely surface indications: the wealth of the mine is below. Also, the argument is repeated for the finite though boundless character of the space. Apart, however, from these picturesque effects, the theory presents so ideal and calculable a unity for all the happenings of space that even if it fails, it will not be a mere brilliant failure; it has set an ideal which physics will never sur-
