When in Cambridge,
I omitted to mention a small
point which arises on page 46
of Statistical Methods (7th Ed.).
Line 7 in the middle paragraph
runs "the latter probability is
always half the former".
Should it not be: "the former
probability is always half the latter"?
There is no 8th Edition available, so
cannot verify whether there is
any alteration there.

My oral examination was a severe test in spite of the considerable amount of work I had put in. As a matter of fact one of the points raised is still occupying me; namely, how to test the significance of the difference between the maxima of two response curves, both as regards the height of the curve (response in hundredweights per acre) and the position with respect to the time at which the maximum occurs.
