I am enclosing herewith a typescript of a short paper on "Polymorphism and Natural Selection", written for your Conference on statistical genetics at Stockholm. I hope you will think it suitable, in spite of the critical remarks I have been led to make about American criticisms, which seem to me to have been just as much a nuisance in recent work on geophysics as in such fields as the genetics of the blood groups, or of the haemoglobins. Perhaps indeed other cases may come to your mind, for the disease seems to be widespread.
