I am sending off at once to you a note on an error which Yates spotted in your linkage paper; luckily it does not need much correction.

At the bottom of page 10, the term:

$$\frac{4165}{2+k^2} - \frac{1823}{1-k^2}$$

ought to be multiplied by 2 / 1; it comes from equation III at the top of page 3.

Yates gives for the new solution

which is practically what you would get by weighting .2944 and .2994 with the quantities of information on which they are based.

I had intended to write more at length on your paper,

which I think is a very fine one, only I will not delay to send in the correction.
