I am so glad to hear in your letter of May 2nd that Oliver and Boyd have at last started to print the German translation which you made of Statistical Methods. It is curious how many obstacles there have been to production of this translation. As I think I mentioned to you, at least two translations were made during the inter-war period, one by von Bonin in Chicago, and another by a German whose name I forget but both failed to get anything published.

As you may not have a copy of the eleventh edition in your hands I am having enclosed with this a statement of the differences between the prefaces to the eleventh and to the eighth editions. I do hope you will find the result rewarding to all your efforts.
