Thanks for your letter. The paper from Finland seems quite appropriate and I am returning it for Darlington to see. I have made a few corrections in the English, but the "modesty" of Ruskea puzzles me.

I am sending herewith also two other papers, one from Yates and the other by C.R.Rao, who is quite an able chap and whom I have been pressing severely to make his work intelligible to such few people as can in any case understand it. This he certainly has tried hard to do, and I imagine he would be very well pleased if you thought his paper suitable for publication in Heredity or anywhere else. I should have put it in the Annals like a shot, but I do not want to press Darlington to the publication of what he may feel unnecessarily heavy material. On the other hand he might think he would like to keep it with a view to putting it in later in some number which could stand the strain.
