Dear Professor.

La Cour would like mice between 4 and 8 weeks old. Apparently any age between these limits is alright. About 5 or 6 mice would be a nice number I gether.

Darlington is back and I have approached him about the cytology of Lythrum. His opinion that we should expect hexasomic segregation seems to be based on his beflief that the only sense that can be made of the counts up to date is that salicaria really has 60 somatic (the counts being too low) which would make hyssopifolia diploid and salicaria hexaploid. Still the most important thing is that he has agreed to have one of his assistmets count the plants for us and look at meiosis in the summer. We might even get root tip counts in time to put in a foot note to the paper, if that course commended itself to you.
